1 The Financial Services Authority (FSA)

The FSA is the independent watchdog that regulates financial services. It requires us to give you this document. Use this information to decide if our services are right for you.

2. Whose products do we offer?

- We offer products from the whole market.
- We only offer products from a limited number of companies.
- We only offer the products from a single company.

3. Which service will we provide you with?

- We will advise and make a recommendation for you after we have assessed your needs.
- You will not receive advice or a recommendation from us. We may ask some questions to narrow down the selection of products that we will provide details on. You will then need to make your own choice about how to proceed.

4. What will you have to pay us for this service?

- No fee, we will be paid by commission from the scheme provider.
- A fee is payable for our advice, which includes the research, recommendation and further administration services that we provide. This is normally payable on completion of the lifetime mortgage or home reversion scheme. Our fee is based on the time we spend working on your behalf. Typically our fee will be £750. We will refund to you any commission we receive from the scheme provider.
- A combination of fee and commission. This will normally include the commission received from the scheme provider and, where necessary an additional fee to cover the cost of our time spent working on your behalf. Again, typically our charges (commissions and fees) would be £750.

You will receive a key facts illustration when considering a particular lifetime mortgage or further information about a particular home reversion scheme, which will tell you about any fees relating to it.

5. Refund of fees

If we charge you a fee, and your lifetime mortgage or home reversion scheme does not go ahead, you will receive:

A full refund.

No refund as our fees are not normally charged until your lifetime mortgage or home reversion scheme completes.

6. Who regulates us?

The Chester Partnership Limited is an appointed representative of Sesame Limited, Oasis Park, Stanton Harcourt Road, Eynsham, Witney, Oxon OX29 4AE which is authorised and regulated by the Financial Services Authority. Sesame Limited's FSA register number is 150427.

Sesame Limited's permitted business is advising on and arranging regulated mortgage contracts.

Home reversion schemes are not regulated by the FSA.

7. What to do if you have a complaint

If you cannot settle your complaint with us, you may be entitled to refer it to the Financial Ombudsman Service.

The Financial Ombudsman Service does not consider complaints about home reversion schemes.

8. Are we covered by the Financial Services Compensation Scheme (FSCS)?

We are covered by the FSCS. You may be entitled to compensation from the scheme if we cannot meet our obligations. This depends on the type of business and the circumstances of the claim.

Mortgage advising and arranging is covered for 100% of the first £30,000 and 90% of the next £20,000 so the maximum compensation is £48,000. Home reversion schemes are not covered by the FSCS.

Further information about compensation scheme arrangements is available from the FSCS.

Message from the Financial Services Authority

If you are at all unsure about which lifetime mortgage or home reversion scheme is right for you, you should ask your adviser to make a recommendation.

Please remember the home reversion schemes are not regulated by the FSA.
